NOMINATION FILING DEADLINE NEARS FOR CANDIDATES IN NAMPAMERIDIAN IRRIGATION DISTRICT'S DIRECTOR ELECTION

Individuals wanting to vie for the post of Director of the Meridian Precinct of the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District in the November 3rd election have until Thursday evening to file their candidacy documents, District officials said today.

NMID will take nominations until close of business on Thursday for the position on the NMID Board of Directors, a post currently held by Will Patterson. The position carries a three year term.

Potential candidates for the Director position must live in the Meridian Precinct plus meet other qualifications set down by law. Individuals who are interested in filing a nominating petition for the directorship should immediately contact the District for more information at (208) 466-7861.

Precinct 2 is roughly bordered by McMillan Road on the North, Eagle Road on the East, Hubbard Road on the South and McDermott Road on the West. A map of the NMID Meridian precinct, along with other information about the election, is available at the NMID website: www.nmid.org.

Under Idaho law, if the deadline for nominations has passed and only one qualified candidate has been nominated, an election will not be held. Instead, the Board of Directors will declare the candidate as elected.

The Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District is a water storage, conveyance and distribution system founded in 1904. The District supplies irrigation water to some 69,000 acres of farmland, residential and commercial lands including pressurized irrigation for more than 15,000 individual parcels of land in Ada and Canyon counties.
