Early Voting Open Until Nov. 6 For NMID Meridian Precinct Director Election

Patrons of the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District have just a week left of early voting before the November 6 election for the person they want to be the Meridian Precinct Director, NMID officials said today.

Patrons who want to vote early need to go to the NMID Office between 8 am and 5 pm at 1503 First Street South in Nampa to cast their vote. In-person voting at the NMID office ends at 5 p.m. on Election Day. Voters will need to complete an oath in which they certify they own land within the boundaries of the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District; that they are a resident of Ada, Boise, or Canyon County and that they possess all the qualifications required by Idaho's general election laws.

Will Patterson and Stephen Warren are running in the election. Patterson is the incumbent while Warren will challenge him for the post that has a three-year term. District officials will declare as elected the person who receives the most votes at the canvass of election returns meeting set for November 20, according to Daren Coon, NMID Secretary Treasurer.

Individuals who already have an absentee ballot must make sure it gets to NMID by 5 p.m. on November 6 so it can be counted in the election returns.

The regular voting polls will be open on Election Day, November 6 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. There are three voting places, one for each precinct. Voters can also find the three polling locations on the District's website: www.nmid.org.

The locations are:

- Precinct No. 1: Horizon Elementary School, 730 North Mitchell Boise, ID 83704;
- Precinct No. 2: Meridian Middle School, 1507 W. 8th Street Meridian, ID 83642; and
- Precinct No. 3: Nampa City Hall, 411 3rd Street South Nampa, ID 83651

The Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District is a water storage, conveyance and distribution system founded in 1904. The District supplies irrigation water to some 69,000 acres of farmland, residential and commercial lands including pressurized irrigation for more than 17,000 individual parcels of land, including 479 subdivisions in Ada and Canyon counties.
