## PATTERSON NAMED ELECTION WINNER FOR NAMPA & MERIDIAN DIRECTOR POST

Will Patterson of Meridian was formally named as the winner of the election to select the Meridian Precinct 2 director of the Treasure Valley's largest irrigation district, officials with the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District announced today.

Patterson was certified as winner of the election by the NMID Board following an official canvasing and certification of the votes in the November 5 election. He will serve a two-year term beginning with the Board's first meeting on January 7, 2014 at the District's Office located at 1503 First Street South in Nampa, according to Daren Coon, NMID Secretary Treasurer.

Patterson was selected over three other individuals in the election. The final official vote totals were:

- Will Patterson 272 votes
- Tom J. LeClaire 119 votes
- Mark D. Olsen 70 votes
- Robert A. Haverfield 3 votes

NMID Precinct 2, Meridian, is roughly bordered by McMillan Road to the North, McDermott Road to the West, Eagle Road to the East and Hubbard Road to the South.

The Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District is a water storage, conveyance and distribution system founded in 1904. The District supplies irrigation water to some 69,000 acres of farmland, residential and commercial lands including pressurized irrigation for more than 15,000 individual parcels of land in Ada and Canyon counties.
