### **THREE DAYS LEFT TO FILE DIRECTOR ELECTION NOMINATIONS FOR NAMPA & MERIDIAN IRRIGATION DISTRICT BOISE PRECINCT**

Just three days are left for individuals who want to compete for a position as Director for the Boise Precinct of the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District in the upcoming November 7 election to file a nominating petition with the District, NMID officials said today.

NMID will take nominations until Thursday (September 28) for the position of Director for Precinct No. 1, the Boise (Perkins) Precinct, a post currently held by Donald Barksdale. The Director position carries a three-year term.

Individuals who want to stand for election must file a nominating petition with the District not later than September 28. Potential candidates for the Director position must live in the Boise Precinct plus meet other qualifications set down by law. Individuals who are interested in filing a nominating petition for the directorship should contact the District for more information at (208) 466-7861.

Under Idaho law, if the deadline for nominations has passed and only one qualified candidate has been nominated, an election will not be held. Instead, the Board of Directors will declare the candidate as elected.

Precinct 1 is roughly bordered by Eagle Road on the West, Chinden Blvd. on the North, 28<sup>th</sup> Street on the East, and Lake Hazel Road on the South. An area of land generally encompassing the Micron Technology Corporation complex is also included. Individuals who are interested in standing for the November election should contact the District as soon as possible to get the forms needed for the nominating petition and information about how to file by Thursday.

The Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District is a water storage, conveyance and distribution system founded in 1904. The District supplies irrigation water to some 69,000 acres of farmland, residential and commercial lands including pressurized irrigation for more than 16,000 individual parcels of land in Ada and Canyon counties.
