### **NAMPA & MERIDIAN IRRIGATION DISTRICT** **TAKING NOMINATIONS FOR MERIDIAN PRECINCT DIRECTOR**

The Treasure Valley’s largest irrigation district is accepting nominations starting September 7 through September 27 for candidates to run for election on November 6 as Director of the Meridian Precinct 2, according to officials with the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District.

Potential candidates for the Director position, currently held by Will Patterson and which has a three year term of office, must live in the Meridian Precinct plus meet other qualifications set down by law. Individuals who are interested in filing a nominating petition for the directorship should contact the District for more information at (208) 466-7861.

Precinct 2 is roughly bordered by Eagle Road on the East, McMillian Road on the North, McDermott Road on the West and Hubbard Road on the South. “This is an opportunity for individuals living in the Meridian Precinct 2 who have an interest in helping manage the affairs of the Irrigation District to campaign for the opportunity to do so. There are three Directors, one in each precinct, who together compose the District’s Board of Directors. A board member serves a vital role in the overall operation of NMID and its water delivery system,” noted Daren Coon, NMID Secretary Treasurer.

Idaho law sets down the election procedures that must be followed and it is critical that individuals meet the window of opportunity for filing a nomination petition.


Under Idaho law, if the deadline for nominations has passed and only one qualified candidate has been nominated, an election will not be held. Instead, the Board of Directors will declare the candidate as elected.

The Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District is a water storage, conveyance and distribution system founded in 1904. The District supplies irrigation water to some 69,000 acres of farmland, residential and commercial lands including pressurized irrigation for more than 16,000 individual parcels of land in Ada and Canyon counties.
