One Week of Early Voting Remains **For NMID Nampa Precinct Director Election**

Patrons of the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District have just a week left of early voting before the November 5th election for the person they want to be the Nampa Precinct Director, NMID officials said today.

Susan Wonnacott and Clinton C. Pline will vie for the position on the election ballot. Pline is the incumbent while Wonnacott will challenge him for the post which has a three-year term.

Absentee ballot requests are no longer accepted, but early in-person voting can be done at the NMID office between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at 1503 First Street South in Nampa. In-person voting at the NMID office ends at, and any absentee ballots must be received, by 5 p.m. on Election Day.

NMID patrons from all three precincts can vote in the election. Voters will need to complete an oath in which they certify they own land within the boundaries of the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District; that they are a resident of Ada, Boise, or Canyon County and that they possess all the qualifications required by Idaho's general election laws.

The person receiving the most votes will be declared elected at the canvass of election returns meeting set for later in November, according to Daren Coon, NMID Secretary Treasurer. People who want more information should call the District at (208) 466-7861.

The regular NMID voting polls will be open on Election Day, November 5, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. There are three voting places, one for each precinct, and they are as follows:

- Precinct No. 1: Horizon Elementary School, 730 North Mitchell Boise, ID 83704;
- Precinct No. 2: Meridian Middle School, 1507 W. 8th Street Meridian, ID 83642; and
- Precinct No. 3: Nampa City Hall, 411 3rd Street South Nampa, ID 83651

The Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District is a water storage, conveyance and distribution system founded in 1904. The District supplies irrigation water to some 69,000 acres of farmland, residential and commercial lands including pressurized irrigation for more than 17,000 individual parcels of land, including 479 subdivisions in Ada and Canyon counties.
