The Water Superintendent of the Treasure Valley's largest irrigation district, Greg Curtis, will provide members of the Boise Lions Club with a comprehensive briefing on the Nampa & Meridian Irrigation District's organization, water delivery system and procedures at a Club meeting on Wednesday, 24 April 2019.

Greg Curtis supervises the NMID water delivery system which includes more than 80 canals that cover more than 500 miles in Ada and Canyon County. NMID also manages approximately 492 residential subdivisions containing more than 17,000 parcels of land in the two counties.

The meeting starts at noon at the Casa Mexico Restaurant located in the shopping area on the northeast corner of Fairview Avenue and Five Mile Road.

The Irrigation District's canals are now running full after water was diverted on April 1 into the head of the historical Ridenbaugh Canal near Barber Park. NMID delivers irrigation water to more than 69,000 acres that include urban, commercial and farmland.
